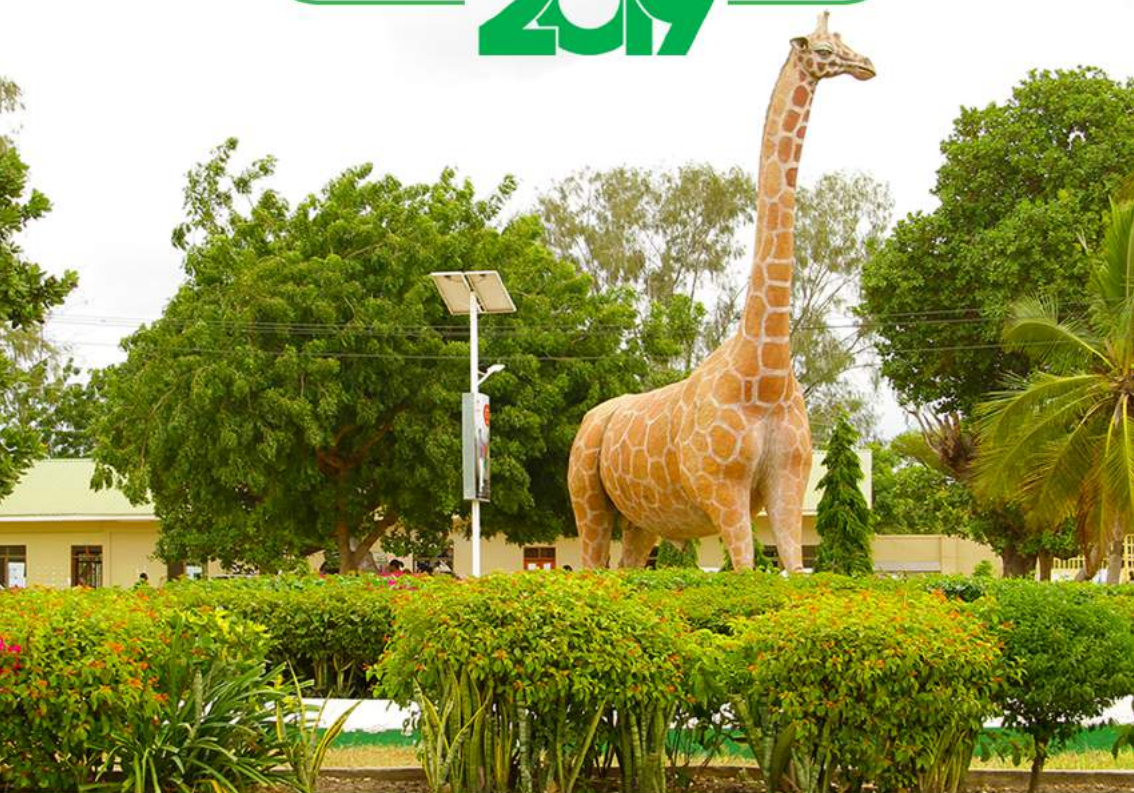

The Kampala International University in Tanzania, (KIUT) began its life, in 2008, as a Dar es Salaam Constituent College (KIU-DCC) of the Kampala International University in Uganda. The original goal of the College was to run academic and professional courses through the open and distance learning mode of course delivery.

On 15th January 2011, the Tanzania Commission for Universities (TCU) issued to the College its interim recognition and Certificate of Provisional Registration (CPR). On 27th September 2012, KIUT was awarded TCU Certificate of Full Registration (CFR).

On 17th July 2017, the TCU approved the Institution's new status of a fully-fledged university under the new name "The Kampala International University in Tanzania (KIUT)".

Objectives

The University aims to provide quality higher education through teaching, research, consultancy and community extension and outreach services. The University's long-term objectives are:

- To produce highly skilled and competent graduates who can make wise and independent decisions enabling them to become respected members of society and able to contribute to their professions, the nation and the global community.
- To become a premier international university in the Great Lakes Region and beyond, providing needs-based, market-driven quality academic programmes.
- To supplement the government's efforts in the provision of higher education and services to the community.
- To provide professional development and continuing learning for practicing professionals.

- To enter into partnerships with other institutions to enhance mutually beneficial goals.

To respond to educational and societal needs by inculcating principles and values of economy and respect for society, and providing a supportive research environment in which scholars at every stage of their careers can flourish.

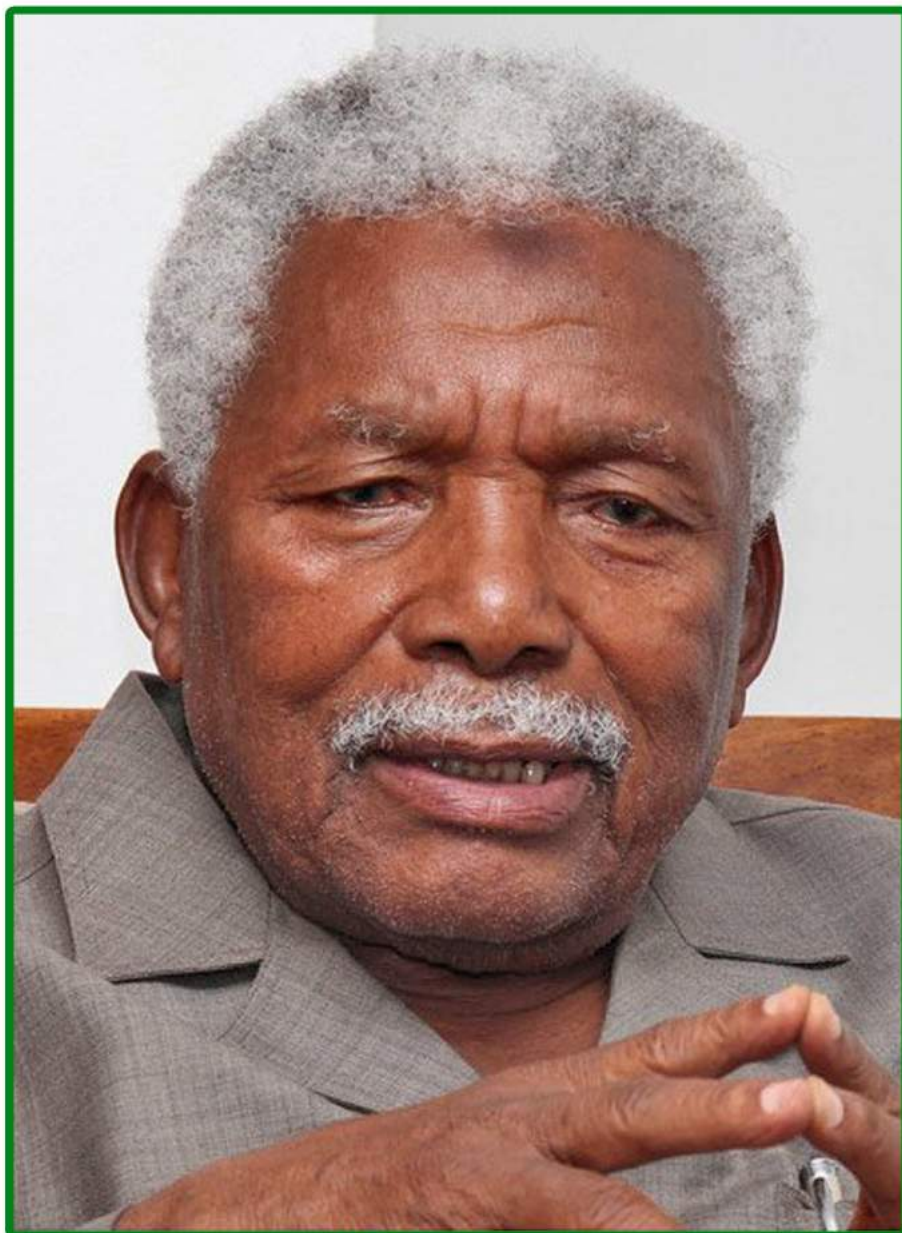
CORE VALUES

The University's operations are in accordance with its Charter and the laws governing universities in Tanzania, including the Tanzania Universities Act and the TCU rules, norms and guidelines.



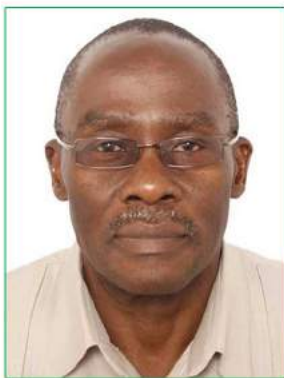

Staffing


As of December 2018, the University had a total workforce of 269, of whom 138 are academic staff. They comprise 11 professors and 20 PhD holders, with the rest are Masters and first degree holders, all of quality levels acceptable by the TCU. The other 131 staff are in management, administration and technical support positions. Over 90 percent are Tanzanian nationals with a variety of technical and professional training. KIUT has 26 non-Tanzanian staff. These comprise fifteen Ugandans, four Kenyans, three Indians, two Cubans, one Nigerian and one Irishman. Of these, 23 are academic and three are in management and administrative jobs.

KIUT has a carrying capacity of 11,000 students for the TCU approved programmes. However, currently the University has only 2,776 students pursuing courses leading to Masters, Postgraduate Diplomas, first degrees, Diplomas, and Certificates in different disciplines. The small number of students is mainly due to the ongoing TCU ban on admission of students. Obviously, this action has also resulted in serious under-utilization of existing physical, academic and other resources already invested in and on the ground at the University.

Medical Laboratories

The University has 13 modern science laboratories catering for, inter alia, Medicine, Surgery, Pharmaceutical Sciences, Medical Laboratory Science, Clinical Medicine, Anatomy, and Basic Sciences. Each laboratory has modern fittings, equipment, resources and materials. The laboratories are managed by qualified science-based lecturers, instructors and laboratory technicians. Ten of the laboratories are reserved for training students in health-based professions and three for education and teacher training. The KIUT science laboratories can serve 50 to 120 students in one session for practical, hands-on training.


KIUT Online Students Information Management System

Online Student Information Manager (OSIM) is a system that collects a student's data from the time of admission to the completion of studies. It even collects data of the University's alumni. The data is stored in a common database, accessible at different levels across all KIUT departments. Through the system, students can apply for different courses offered at KIUT from the comfort of their homes.

OSIM consists of several modules, the main ones being the admission, academic and finance modules. The first allows oversight of all admission activities. It can provide reports on, for example, qualified candidates or student admission for each course. The second allows access to student academic records, and can produce, among other things, statements of semester results and transcripts, Faculty Board and Senate reports and graduation certificates. The finance module provides students financial records, and can disaggregate fees defaulters and compliers, for example.

OSIM also supports quality assurance, through which students can assess their lecturers' performance. OSIM's data is encrypted to ensure security.

Currently under construction at the Gongo la Mboto campus, the teaching hospital will train medical doctors and related personnel while providing health services to the surrounding community and conducting medical research. The hospital, which has reached 80 per cent completion, will provide 875 beds for Tanzanian patients.

Considering the financial position of some families in Tanzania, the University expects to provide some services at a nominal fee to deserving members of the community in its planned teaching hospital.

Transport Facilities

The six buses with a total capacity of 326 are used to ferry students to teaching hospitals and laboratories in the Dar es Salaam and Coast regions for practical sessions. The buses are also available for students and supervisors for outreach programmes.

Outreach Programmes

KIUT has had a tradition of reaching out and enhancing good relations with the surrounding community and the general public. During the academic year 2017/2018, the University participated in several community activities including the following:

- a) The Uhuru torch race;
- b) National exhibitions such as Sabasaba Trade Fair, Nanenane Farmers' Day, Higher Education and related exhibitions such as those that are organised or coordinated by TCU and other Government recognised institutions;
- c) Environmental cleanliness and hygiene campaigns within and outside the University;
- d) Voluntary contributions to blood banks of various hospitals;
- e) Scanning people's health and giving due advice for residents of Dar es Salaam and Coast regions;
- f) Contributing materials and participating in the promotion of cleanliness and hygiene of public hospitals in Dar es Salaam and Coast Regions;
- g) Providing security services for the University and surrounding areas;
- h) Providing opportunities for enterprising youth and women to run small businesses within the University and its surroundings; and
- i) Providing scholarships to qualifying students, mainly from proven poor families in the Tanzanian community, through the district administrative structure. The University's management has plans to scale up this endeavour.

Collaboration with Hospitals

The University has a good working relationship with several hospitals in and outside Tanzania. We have signed MoUs with the following hospitals for clinical rotations:

The University also enjoys a good working relationship with the Pharmacy Council, the Health Laboratory Practitioners Council, Tanganyika Medical Board, and National Council for Technical Education among others. Plans are underway to establish links with other universities, international research organisations, grant-awarding institutions and other academic associations in the region and beyond.

Funding and support

KIUT has a stable source of funding for operations and capital development. It is fully backed by the investors for capital development and a portion of the tuition fees is used to finance operating activities. Plans are under way to start a University Consultancy Bureau, which would enable the University to tap into a wider network of projects that our able staff can participate in. Plans are also underway to establish a Grants Office. This will attract additional funds for research and other projects. KIUT receives support from its sister universities in Uganda.
